**JEFF KIDWELL**  
Edmond, Oklahoma

Jeff Kidwell is an instructor with the University of Central Oklahoma’s School of Music in Edmond. His duties include Trombone Instructor, Trombone Ensemble Director, Director of Jazz Ensembles and Assistant Director of Jazz Studies and Jazz Lab Operations. From 1998 to 2006, Kidwell served as Assistant Director of Bands with the Edmond Public Schools where his duties included Marching Band, Symphonic Bands, and Jazz Ensembles at both the high school and middle school levels. Prior to coming to Edmond, Mr. Kidwell taught in the Norman Public Schools, The University of Oklahoma and Oklahoma City University.

Kidwell is a third generation Oklahoma music educator. Both his father and grandfather were band directors in the state and his mother was a vocal music teacher in rural Oklahoma. He credits his love of music to his parents, public school and college teachers.

Mr. Kidwell is a highly sought-after musician/clinician who has performed with a wide variety of groups from the Count Basie Orchestra to Aretha Franklin and Toby Keith. Jeff has also been a musician for Norwegian Cruise Lines and played for National tours of Broadway musicals such as “Wicked”, “The Book of Mormon” and Oprah Winfrey’s “The Color Purple”. Mr. Kidwell is the trombonist and arranger for one of the Southwest’s top party and show bands, “Souled Out” and is the conductor/music director for The Oklahoma Hall of Fame awards presentation which is broadcast annually on PBS.

Kidwell is a Conn-Selmer Artist and has been a featured clinician throughout North America including the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic, the Brandon Manitoba Jazz Festival, the New Mexico State Jazz Festival, the Oklahoma Summer Arts Institute Honor Jazz Ensemble and numerous appearances with Oklahoma All-State and All-District honor bands.

Jeff lives in Edmond, with his wife Susan and their three daughters, Madeline, Gracie, and Emma Jane.



**J. ERIC WILSON**

J. Eric Wilson, Professor of Ensembles and Conducting, has been Director of Bands at Baylor University since 2006. He provides administrative leadership for all aspects of the band program, conducts the Wind Ensemble, and teaches and oversees the undergraduate and graduate conducting curriculum. Additionally, he has supervised student teachers and served as Chair of the Ensemble Division. Dr. Wilson is a former president of the Big 12 Band Directors Association and a Past-President of the CBDNA Southwestern Division. He has been elected into the American Bandmasters Association and the Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity, and honored as Outstanding Professor for Tenured Teaching by Baylor University in 2014.

Dr. Wilson is in demand as a conducting clinician, adjudicator, and performing artist. As a conductor, he has directed numerous regional honor bands and conducted his own groups at conventions including the Texas Music Educators Association, College Band Directors National Association, American Bandmasters Association, and The Midwest Clinic. He was a featured contributor in the 2015 Meredith Music publication, *Rehearsing the Band, Volume 2*. Prior to joining the Baylor faculty, he served twelve years on the faculty of Abilene Christian University. Dr. Wilson holds both a Doctor of Musical Arts degree (wind band conducting) and a Master of Music degree (saxophone performance) from the University of Michigan and a Bachelor of Music Education degree from Abilene Christian University. Prior to his university appointments, Dr. Wilson taught in the Texas public school system. In addition to his performing opportunities as conductor, clinician, and saxophonist, Dr. Wilson enjoys spending time with his wife, Lynette, and their children: Blake and his wife, Bailey; Meredith and her husband, Brandon; Luke; and Caleb.
